Upon arrival, at approx. 1000hrs., the breeder had seven adult dogs and fourteen puppies. All dogs were identified with microchips and the puppies were identified with kennel cards. I scanned four dogs and compared the numbers with AKC records. All the dogs were housed in outdoor kennels that were approx. 10'X20' in size and made of welded wire. They were all clean and in good repair. They all had shade covers and clean fresh water. The puppies were housed in indoor/outdoor kennels. The outdoor area was welded wire kennels that were approx. ten foot by six foot covered kennels. The inside area was an approx. four foot by four foot area. Both of these areas were clean and in good repair and had automatic waters providing clean fresh water. The dogs were all clean, healthy, and in good spirits. The exercise area was three large fenced in areas that had plenty of shade and fresh water. There was also two large training fields that could also serve as exercise fields as well. Four litter and four ownership records were reviewed and found to be within all AKC rules and regulations. The breeder was in compliance with all rules and regulations with the AKC and should be commended on the overall care and condition of her dogs as well as the organization of her paperwork.
